Poster Competition- District Level

All the participants are hereby instructed to follow the rules and regulations hereby mentioned below. Participants need to make sure that they are abide by all the rules and regulations.

- Size of the Poster: A2
- Materials Allowed: card board / chart / cloth paper/ or any eco friendly materials, Natural colors, Sketches, Pencil, paper cuttings, etc.
- Prohibited materials: flex, vinyl, thermocol, etc., pollutants.
- Poster should reflect any one of the given themes.
- The language of explanation may be either in Telugu or English.
- The same poster should be carried to the district level competition.
- No Project type materials or kits allowed for presentation.

Competition Procedure

- 36 Posters from General theme and 36 Posters from Swatantra ka Amrut Mahotsav theme will be allowed to participate in district level competition.
- The Selection of 36 Posters will be done by KOUSHAL-2021 district team.
- All the evaluation and judgments will be fair and square and no recommendations are encouraged. The decision of the judges is final, and no further discussion will be entertained in relation to their decision.

- Selected Posters will be invited for participation in **district Level on Dec 29th 2021** at the respective venues.
- Top 3 posters of each district will be called for State Level Competition on **5th January at Vijayawada (Same Poster Should be carried)**
